Summer School Funding Statement 2021

Transition to Secondary School is challenging for most pupils, this coupled with disrupted learning and the effects of the pandemic the challenges around transition from Primary to Secondary School were exacerbated for the Year 6 cohort.

To help overcome any concerns and alleviate heightened anxieties Northfleet School for Girls delivered a well-attended 5 day summer school to support Year 6 students with their transition from Secondary School, giving students the opportunity to meet their peers and members of staff and familiarise themselves with the school site ahead of joining the school in September 2021.
